Why might you want to use this service?

If you see your child is:

- Finding it difficult to make friends or interact with others
- Not growing out of certain behaviour

You know your child best. If you feel they may need support, let's have a conversation about your child's development.

We work closely with families/carers of children aged 0-6 years to develop the skills children need to take part in daily activities and achieve the best possible outcomes throughout their lives.

NDIS Early Childhood Early Intervention (ECEI) supports families who wish to better understand their child's support needs, or have recently received a diagnosis and are looking for support to access the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).
