



Statement of Attainment: Introduction to Cookery Away from Base Program.

Course details:

Do you have a passion for food, creative cooking and working within a team? Ever considered a job as a cook or a chef? This commercial cookery course is for you. This course is in partnership with the National Indigenous Culinary Institute who can assist you in obtaining an Apprenticeship as a Chef or another job in the industry following the program.

This course will run as an Away from Base (AFB) program. This entails block study where you travel to TAFE NSW Hamilton to study. If you reside more than 90 minutes from the training location and are ABSTUDY eligible, you may be eligible for support with travel, accommodation and meals via ABSTUDY Away from Base funding. This study will require you to submit an Abstudy application through Services NSW (Centrelink). Don't worry, we can support you with this process.

This course will cover:

- SITHCCC001 - Use Cookery Skills Effectively
- SITHCCC002 - Prepare Simple Dishes
- SITXFSA001 - Use Hygienic Practices for Food Safety

Block Dates:

- **Block 1:** Tues 8 Nov – Thurs 10 Nov 2022
- **Block 2:** Tues 29 Nov- Thurs 1 Dec 2022

Note: The Monday and Friday will require travel for AFB students.

There is also additional work placement requirements. We can also assist with this.
